Dear Tribal Members & Community Members:

As you may have seen or heard two (2) presumptive cases of the COVID-19 were identified in Page, Arizona yesterday, March 19, 2020. Today one (1) of them was confirmed with COVID-19. In order to further protect our tribal members and community members the Kaibab Band of Paiute Indians Tribal Council has approved the recommendation of the Tribal COVID-19 team in enacting COVID-19 Pandemic: Level 2. This means the following are effective immediately:

- Community Members if you have guests/visitors from off the reservation you will be quarantined for 14 days to protect the community.
 - 14-day quarantine if showing signs and symptoms or if confirmed COVID19 case
 - In-Home sheltering until further notice (a flyer is attached)
 - Gas Station – C-store closed until further notice
 - Gas Pumps will remain on
 - 2 employees will staff store for any pump problems during the hours of 10 am - 6 pm each day.
 - Community Members may call the store 643-6040 for a call-in order. Please use the rear door.
 - Tribal Office – Closed
 - All calls to the Tribal Office will be forwarded to Daniel Bullets, Admin. Assistant who will contact the appropriate individual.
 - All work will be done at home by employees via teleworking
 - Essential Staff determined by Tribal Council will remain doing essential functions as outlined in Department Response Plan
 - Essential functions for community will continue
 - KPT COVID19 Response Team will have a conference call every day at 9:00 a.m. until further notice.
 - Non-Essential Travel Discouraged for all Tribal members and employees
 - EXCEPTION: Work, Grocery Store, Medical

I know some of our programs are posting online activities that our families and students can do while we go through sheltering and self-quarantine. I want to end this update with words a tribal member elder wrote to me: "Remember way back when, the Europeans brought their diseases with them, killed many of our people, but we survived. We will again."
